



Pierce County Career Day 2016

Bus drop-off and pick-up:

Please have your bus drivers enter the Blue Gate Parking Lot for student drop off. (map to fairgrounds at <http://www.thefair.com/map/>) Students will be picked up at the same location at the conclusion of the event.

Orientation: Industry professionals will give the student safety orientation on the bus upon arrival.

School Check In: Enter the fairgrounds through the blue gate entrance and proceed to Showplex. Upon entering the building there will be several registration tables where you may check in your school (send in only 2 representatives). Please have your students wait outside in an organized manner and clear of the doors so other school representatives can enter the building.

Permission Slips/Media Releases:

Please print off the student Construction Career Day permission form/media release and bring completed forms to the fairgrounds. You will be asked for these at registration. **STUDENTS WHO ARE UNDER 18 AND DO NOT HAVE A PARENT SIGNATURE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE EVENT.** Students may be asked to speak to the media and may be videotaped for a promotional video to be used at schools, etc next year to market the event. Please let students know they may be asked to speak on camera for promotional video. (This is optional)

School Roster: You will be asked for a roster of students at registration (in confirmation email). This is for safety measures while attending the event. **ALL GROUPS WILL BE ASKED FOR THIS FORM NO MATTER HOW LARGE OR SMALL YOUR GROUP.** It must contain the names of all students, teachers, and chaperones in attendance (including cell phone numbers).

After you have checked in, proceed with your students to pick up backpacks. The backpacks will have safety glasses, ear protection, event evaluation, and various other information from our sponsors.

Chaperone Expectations:

- ✓ **Be sure your students are wearing the proper clothing for participating before leaving the school. (Weather appropriate attire-Long pants, close toed shoes-IF NOT DRESSED APPROPRIATELY, STUDENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE EVENT.) SAFETY GLASSES ARE TO BE WORN AT ALL TIMES BY EVERYONE AT THE EVENT.**
- ✓ Participate fully in guiding your students throughout each of the activity areas. Please do not let them wander unattended.
- ✓ We will be providing a BBQ lunch and fair scones to students and chaperones
- ✓ This is a non-smoking area for students and staff.

Event details: After the safety orientation is complete, your group will be free to select activities inside the Showplex that they are interested in doing. Equipment will be in areas outside the Showplex (on both sides of building) and will be clearly defined; students will need to go to designated areas to obtain safety equipment before entering the outdoor area.

Lunch: Lunch will be provided for all students and chaperones. You will be assigned a lunch time upon arrival. As your group enters the lunch area they will fill out student evaluation forms and return to staff-this is their ticket to lunch. The evaluation is in their backpacks. If you have any students with known food allergies, please advise them to bring their own lunch.

Scones: Will be available at the information booth.

PLEASE NOTE-REGISTRATION WILL FILL UP FAST AND WE HAVE A WAITING LIST. If you anticipate not filling all of your registered spots, please let us know so that we can let other students participate.
